

Police & Fire Commission Meeting Minutes – March 6, 2019

Chairman Krauski called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm and the Deputy Clerk confirmed appropriate meeting notice had been given.

2. **Approve minutes from February 6, 2019 meetings:** Motion by Wiemer to approve the February 6, 2019 minutes as written; second by Mercier. Motion carried 3-0.
3. **Election of Secretary for the Police and Fire Commission:** Motion by Mercier to nominate Wiemer as Secretary of the Police & Fire Commission; second by Le Duc. No other nominations were given. Motion carried unanimously.
4. **Chief to promote one part-time officer to the position of full-time officer:** Buerger stated the department has an excellent part time officer that he would like to promote to a full-time position. Matthew Volz has been employed by the City of Oconomowoc Police Department since May of 2017 first as a Community Service Officer and after he completed the academy he became a part-time officer and has successfully completed field training. He has been highly recommended from a number of officers. He graduated in May of 2018 with an Associate Degree in Criminal Justice. He also graduated in December of 2018 from Blackhawk Community College with his certification. Buerger is requesting promoting Matthew Volz to the position of full-time police officer.
5. **Consider/act on confirmation of Chief's appointment:** Motion by Wiemer to confirm Chief Ron Buerger's promotion of part-time officer Matthew Volz to full-time; second by Mercier. Motion carried 4-0.
6. **Introduction of Officer:** Matthew Volz introduced his family to the Commission. The members congratulated him on his appointment.
7. **Comments from Police & Fire Commission members:** None.

Motion by Wiemer to adjourn; second by Mercier. Motion carried 4-0. The meeting adjourned at 5:07 p.m.
